INFORMATION FOR SEWAGE CONNECTIONS

1. Contact a contractor or plumber to commence construction.

DO IT YOURSELF CONNECTIONS TO THE T.V.R.S.S.C. SYSTEM ARE ILLEGAL

- 2. Apply for a T.V.R.S.S.C. Permit at the Alberta Beach Village Office. PERMITS ARE VALID FOR ONE YEAR.
- 3. Obtain a "Private Sewage Permit" from your contractor, plumber, or an accredited agency.

EVERY NEW INSTALLATION WILL REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF A CLEAN-OUT AT THE CONNECTION AND THE CLEAN-OUT LINE MUST BE EXTENDED TO GROUND LEVEL.

EACH CLEAN-OUT LINE MUST BE SECURELY CAPPED AND PROTECTED FROM DAMAGE.

BACKFILLING AT THE PROPERTY LINE CONNECTION CAN NOT BE DONE UNTIL THE COMMISSION'S INSPECTOR HAS APPROVED THE CONNECTION.

- 4. It is strongly recommended that your contractor physically locate the stub before digging the line to the house. Engineered drawings may be viewed at the Alberta Beach Village office during regular business hours, please call 780-924-3181 or visit our website at tvrssc.com under the Maps tab.
- 5. Damage to municipal property as the result of work involved in connecting to the sewer system is the responsibility of the property owner and must be remedied to the satisfaction of the municipality.
- 6. The Municipality reserves the right to charge the property owner the costs involved to correct unsatisfactory restoration.
- 7. Septic tanks must be collapsed or filled in for safety reasons.
- 8. INSTALLATIONS THAT ARE NOT CONNECTED TO HOUSEHOLD SEWER SYSTEMS MUST BE CAPPED AND BURIED.
